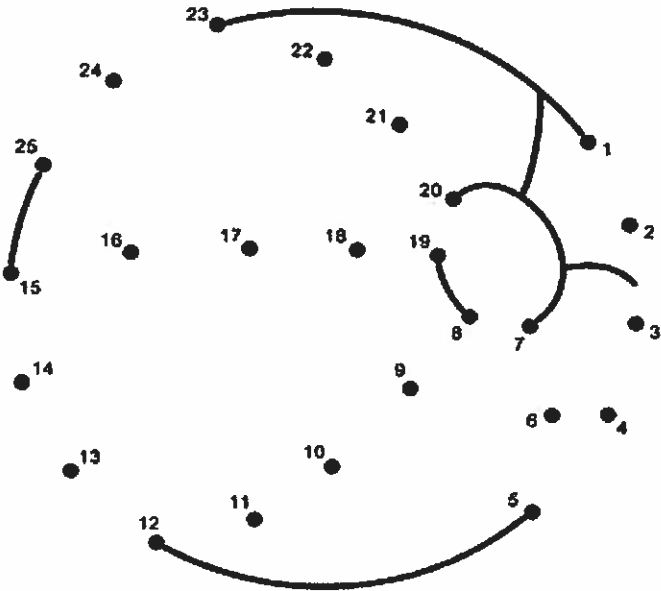

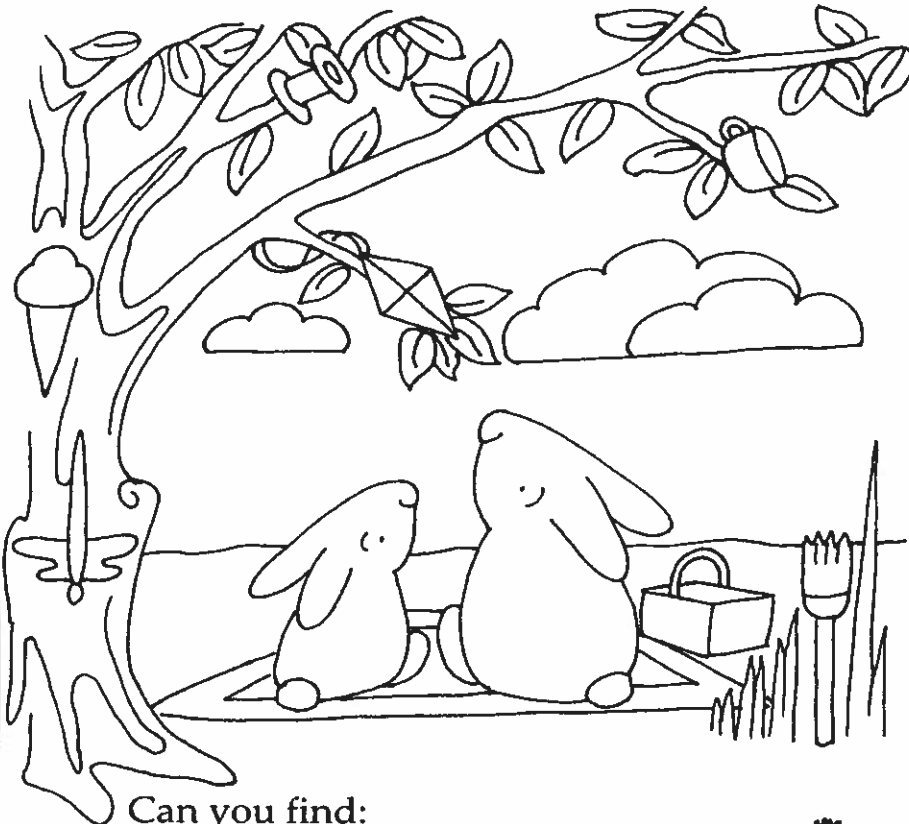

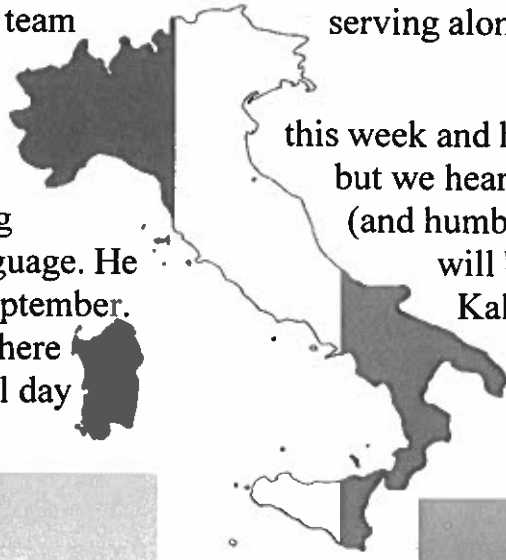
Parks, focaccia and gelato!

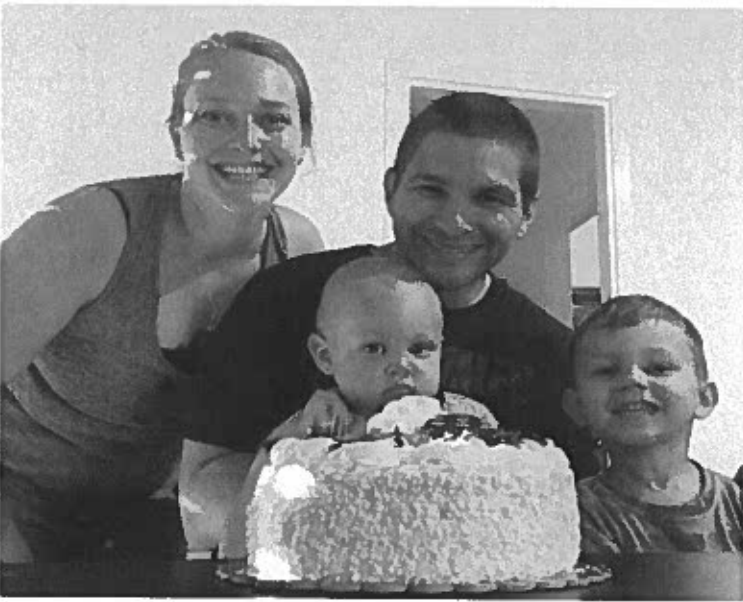

language will be put to the test while we're out but also means less formal learning. In one particular trip, we will be helping translate for a team serving alongside of our colleagues in Trento.

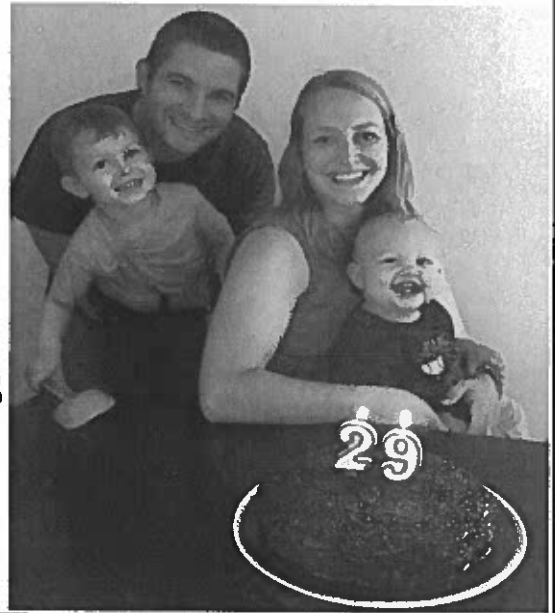
