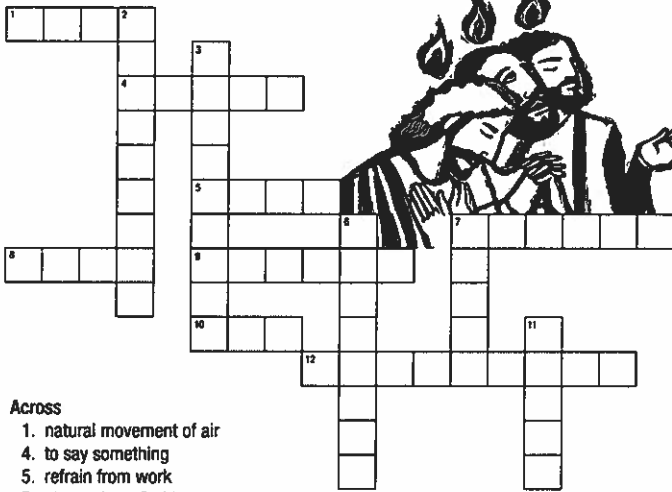

FLANNERY FAMILY UPDATE

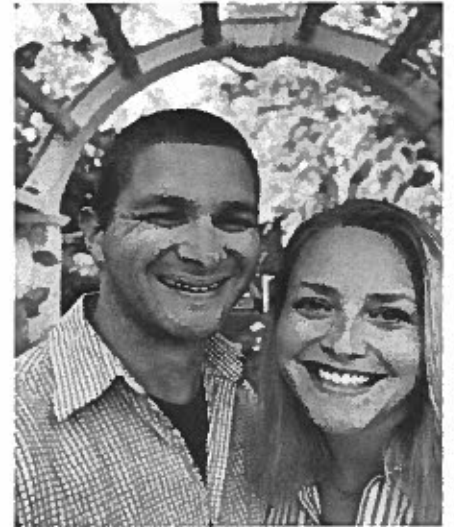
Summering in America :-)

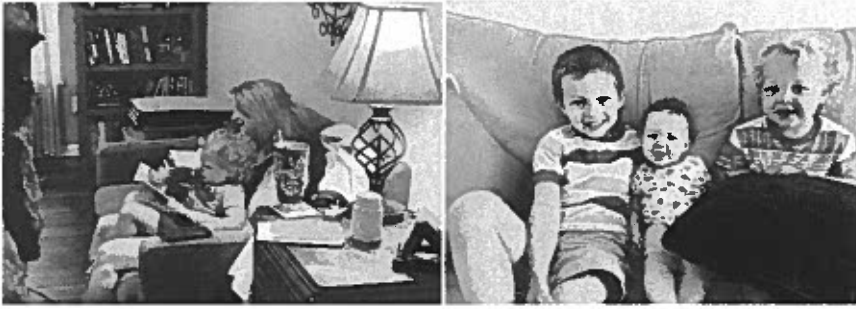
Celebrating our Birthdays with a little gifted getaway.
