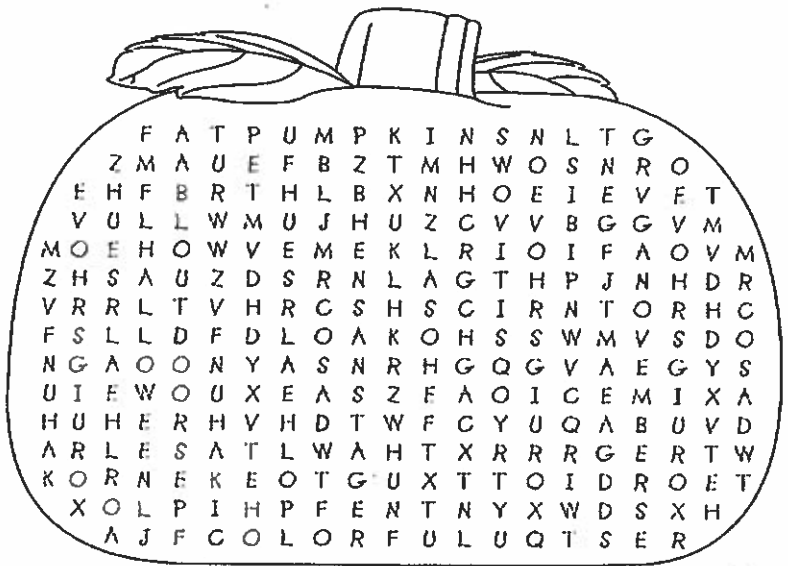

* Baby Bottle Campaign- Your organization or you individually can participate. *Our church participates in January, but donations are accepted at any time.*

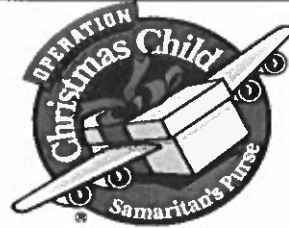

Clothing and Accessories, that could be a shirt, socks or a hair bow. School items and toys to fit the age of child you choose.

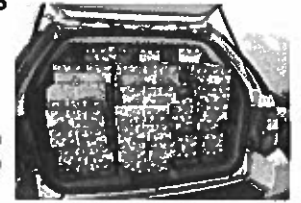
* There are things you can not send.
